





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Let me take an example now. Of these six lines 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16 as you can observe 12 is parallel to 15 so which means in the graph 12 will have a line arrow pointing towards 15 and 15 is also parallel to 12 obviously so there will be a symmetric arrows from 12 to 15 and 15 to 12 so on and so forth.



The graph will look like this and the corresponding matrix will, let me populate the corresponding matrix, there will be a 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1 this way. You can pause the video and maybe check if I am right. I have put a 1 let's say in 13 and 14, 13th column and 14th column because 13 is parallel to 14 so is 14 with 13. 14 is parallel to 13. You see something very nice about this matrix of course the diagonals have 1 adding to that we observe the matrix is symmetric you see on the right side. You see below the diagonal on the left side both are exactly the same that is because Li, Lj, lj, li, both have either 1 or 0 that is because two lines are either parallel to each other or they are not parallel to each other.



Anyways another small observation which I made just now that whenever a line is parallel to another line let us say here 14 is parallel to 11 and 11 is parallel to something else 13 then 14 will be parallel to 13. Correct. This may not be true in real life where a person A is friends with person B and a person B is friends with person C. Person A needn't be friends with person C. This is not true in real life with the friendship relation but with parallel lines relation this seems to be true, correct.

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
