Supposititious is to false as spurious is to inciting, b duplicate, c exhilarating, d not authentic, e not technical. And the last word mulct is to defraud as ratiocination is to reasoning, bilk, c detective, d proportion, e self defense.

And the answers are for the first one: Mercury is to caduceus as Neptune is to tried, it is their weapons weaponries. So, Neptune is known to carry trident, so that is the analogy. Enervate is to stringent these are the opposites. So, choices d stultify is to enliven invigorate and brighten are same and enervate and stringent are opposite choices is correct answer is d stultify is to enliven. Next dolt is to dour as numbskull is to sullen. Next is mendacity is to distrust and the answer choices say mendacity is what dishonesty; when you are dishonest people distrust you.

So look at all the choices now: bagging and charity that is opposite, stupidity failure that is a cause, truth and false hood opposites, untruth and doubtful not really so. Integrity when you have a integrity you inspire confidence, when you have mendacity you inspire distrust that is the analogy; so choice e integrity and confidence.

Next was carelessness and jeopardize: carelessness causes things to the jeopardized. So, choices a penalty justilies you are justilies and we are slab with the penalty, but does not answer is fail; failure discouragement, no not really. Carefulness and security and neglect and endanger this is your answer. So, carelessness leads to jeopardy and neglect leads to endanger; that is the best choice here. Crowding and discomforties it can be to discomfort, but we are looking at the same level of problems as carelessness and jeopardy.

Flamboyant is to rococo as ornate is to baroque: that is the right answer that is style of. So, rococo kind of artist style and or baroque is also kind of an ornate style, so rococo is flamboyant baroque is ornate to decorate, so that comes from the world of art.

Next one hypertension to hypotension: height to low. But here we are not talking about high and low as simplistic, but excessive and deficiency so best choice is b. Choice b excessive and defiant. In hypertension you have excessive condition in hypo tension you have deficiency so this is what we are talking. It is not simply high and low.

Next is president and justification so the best choices authority and sanction. Then there is a president, there is a justification and then there is a authority; authority can cause sanction. You say then submission, tradition, and novelty, orthodoxy, and heresy the related but not in the same context as authority and sanction.

Next is philologist and language; what does the numismatist do? Studies stamps, herbalist studies, tropical flowers. Philatelist collect does charms and fish its theologist study fish. So, answer is your e conchologist, like a philologist which studies languages conchologist studies shells; study of shells. Next word was laurel and victor: you get apologies and you have a person who is applauded, so best choice is choice b Oscar and movies star; Oscar awards are given to movie stars.

Next one was corvine and crow; anything related to crow is corvine, anything relate to dinosaur is not elephantine. Lioness is the gender opposite gender of lion, but so from crow from you get the adjective corvine from viceroy you get the adjective viceregal, so choice c. Urbane and urban are totally different thing; urbane is an attitude towards life, urban is a anyone how leaves in urban city areas it is a choice of adjectives.

Next was zealot and fanaticism: do you have four choices, five choices impostor and sham what does it zealot do practices fanaticisms. Orator does not practice frenzy, empire does not practice game, vagabond is vagrant and parasite leave of food. Zealot azealot, practices fanaticism and impostor practices sham; so choice a.

Next was pain and anodyne: anodyne curves pain it is like a soothing; savagery music not really. Harshness softness they are opposites, trifle enormity opposites, accident insurance. So, you need swales in your grief, you need a anodyne in your pain, gives this slowest to someone in their grief. So, choice b is the answer. Next was forgery is to signature, it is fake to genuine. Forgery you know faking somebody signature, fake to genuine. So, answer is fake and genuine.

Proxy and delegate not really, carbon copy and original many of us may but car carbon copy need not be illegal, here the question is of legality also; fake and forgery, signature and genuine. Embezzlement in blank cheque; you can give someone blank cheque. So, these are not really legal issues.

Next was anxiety to allay as grief is to; so you allay somebody's anxiety, you reduce somebody anxiety that is allay. And grief you banish grief, you condole grief, heighten grief or assuage grief or display; you assuage grief which is reducing somebody's grief its likes giving soulless.

Next was minotaur is to bull; again these are those gropers kinds of creature that we just we saw in a la last class. So, chimera all these are mythical mythological creatures. So, bull is minotaur and chimera is lion, not a heifer not a goddess not a tiger not a dog; a lion half lion half human, minotaur is half human half bull, chimera is half lion half human that is the connection and an analogy. Sylvan woods terrestrial. So, sylvan forest John Keats to the grecian and he uses the term sylvan. So, you know charming beautiful place they lots of woods thick with woods.

And terrestrial is pertaining to the land. So, is it urban fear earth planets stars is related to earth; so terrestrial earth, tera. Sign is to progenitor-progenitor gives birth to assign. And decedent, so you have children brother and sister progeny and guardian; so ancestors lead to descendent we say my ancestor (Refer Time: 15:52) a progenitor. So, this is the analogy, progenitor leads to sign ancestors lead to descendents.

Next was inveigle leads to cajole as malign these are synonyms. You want to persuades someone is to inveigle, and when you malign someone you are slandering, you are tarnishing their images. So, you are not acclaiming you are eulogize a compiling; eulogize is the big opposite, here we are taking about the analogy is all about synonyms you malign you slander.

Next was cygnet and swan. So, we are talking about the higher in the smaller version.; so horse is to colt. Stallion would be a more way find version of you know one of the breeds of horse; so here horse is to colt. Hercules is to club, what quipped is to now we Hercules use to carry a club that was his weapon of choice or choice of weapon or whatever. A quipped does not carry trident, Neptune carry trident. These are greed Goddess spear or poisoned bow quipped weapon was arrow.

If you people know the a legend of or the mythology of and quipped, quipped is the little creature that flies around all over the place wind creature. And on Valentines Day you have picture of a quipped, the bow and narrow in a idea is if it strikes someone with a narrow people falling in love. So, that is the legend of quipped.

Ogle is to eyes: you ogle gaze someone with your eyes. So, maneuver or maneuver something with not necessarily fingers or human beings or minds although you can use your mind here, but here the idea is to maneuver something with your sensors, so hands. So, ogle with eyes and maneuver with hands are choice e. Purloin is an archaic word or

higher order word for the stealing. So, nebulous is archaic word is an archaic higher order word for e vague or cloudy; nebulous whether that it can also been nebulous ideas cloudy ideas.

Next was rubescent, is a red: it is a noun given to the adjective colors. So, cerulean is to blue and something you said touch of cerulean to blue we do not you usually talked that all of us are aware of that, but it is for the purposes of your exams that you should know. Serulean is connected with blue: the blueness of something, the redness of something is rubescent, the blueness of something is cerulean. Genuine is the opposite of simulated, you simulate something. Unaffected is the opposite of; unaffected what is the unaffected? It is not like you remain unaffected by something, unaffected means we are very down to earth and that is opposite is bombastic; you are always praising yourself.

Next was rachitic and recites. So, when you have you are suffering from the disease called reckets which adjective is rachitic. So, when you are suffering from disease called a scurvy the adjective is scorbutic, is scorbutic, is scorbutic is related to scurvy disease. And next was uranium: uranium as a element effaceable that is the property. And gold's property is not diamond or ideas or although golden ideas we are aware of, but not exactly here. Nuclears or atoms choice b answer is e malleable. So, golden malleable just as uranium is fissionable property.

Next word was supposititious: supposititious is based on assumptions rather than facts. So, supposititious is to false, so almost synonyms. And is spurious is again false. So, supposititious is to false that spurious is to inciting duplicate exhilarating not authentic not technical; so best choice is d not authentic.

Next was mulct is to defraud: as ratiocination is to a reasoning, b bilk, c detective, d proportion, e self defense. Now mulct is to expect money by imposing fine, almost like cheating you know they want penalizing someone for something very small and you mulct that you extract. Ratios innovation is a process of exact thinking. So, one is extract money by fine, by cheating and so you are expecting something. Ratios innovation is extracting thinking by reasoning. So that is the way that is the analogy here. Mulct defraud, ratios innovation reasoning a; bilk is to obtain money by cheating so that is a synonym.
