- ▶ Reduces the size of the spreadsheet when it is saved



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# Linking

- ▶ Since our spreadsheet does not contain the image



# Linking

- ▶ Reduces the size of the spreadsheet when it is saved
- ▶ Since our spreadsheet does not contain the image
- ▶ Enables the user to modify both the files separately



# Linking

- ▶ Any changes made to the image file

- ▶ **Whenever you want to send this spreadsheet to a different computer or user**



# Disadvantage of Linking

- ▶ Whenever you want to send this spreadsheet to a different computer or user
- ▶ You will have to send both the spreadsheet as well as the image file



# Disadvantage of Linking

- ▶ Whenever you want to send this spreadsheet to a different computer or user
- ▶ You will have to send both the spreadsheet as well as the image file
- ▶ Have to keep track of the stored location
